What is Interchange?

Interchange is the fee paid by Card Acquirers to Card Issuers (banks) for the processing of each individual card payment transaction.

How do card processing costs work?

When a card transaction is processed through your acquirer, there are three different cost components:

- The Interchange fee that goes to the card issuing bank
- The Scheme Fee that goes to Visa or Mastercard
- The acquirer fee
